



Did you know having HIV places you at a greater risk for a severe COVID infection?

- It is recommended that PLWH still receive the jab regardless of cd4 or viral load
- 2 doses + booster is recommended for severe or untreated HIV
- Both Pfizer and Moderna have been tested and approved for use in the Immunocompromised
- PLWH are NOT at any heightened risk for injuries from the SARS-Coronavirus vaccine than those without HIV
